I can describe how the natural world looks different at different times of the year.



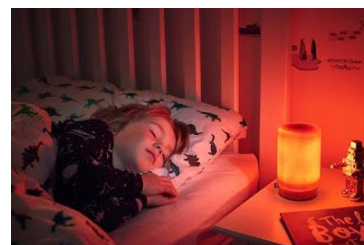
Animals including humans
