Moon Landings

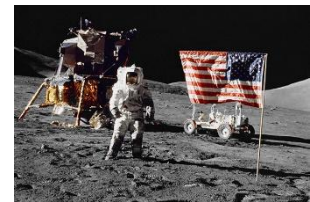
The Space Race was between Russia and USA.
